

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ESSEX

BY-LAW #187

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT AND ABATE
PUBLIC NUISANCES.

WHEREAS Section 210 (140) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that Councils of local municipalities may pass by-laws for prohibiting and abating public nuisances.


AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit and abate public nuisances in the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF ESSEX ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. (a) "Municipality" shall mean the Corporation of the Town of Essex.
(b) "Public thoroughfare" shall include sidewalks and travelled portions of highways located in the municipality.
2. No person shall collect in a crowd thereby obstructing a public thoroughfare.
3. No person, obstructing a public thoroughfare, shall refuse to disburse when ordered to do so by a police officer or by-law enforcement officer of the municipality.
4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this by-law shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction thereto to a penalty as set out in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P. 33 for each offence, exclusive of costs, which penalty and costs shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act.
5. Any by-law inconsistent with this by-law is repealed.
6. This by-law comes into full force and effect on the day it is finally passed.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME THIS 20TH DAY OF APRIL, 2000.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 20TH DAY OF APRIL, 2000.

ONTARIO COURT OF JUSTICE

PROVINCIAL OFFENCES ACT

PART I
