

## How do I purchase interment rights?

### **1. Who do I contact to discuss my options?**

The Superintendent and Caretaker of Cemeteries is responsible for meeting with family members on-site to assist in selecting a lot. An appointment can be made by telephone at 519-776-7336.

### **2. I have selected my lot, now what?**

You will need to contact the Clerks Office at 519-776-7336 to arrange a day and time to review and sign your contract and receive your Certificate of Interment Rights.

### **3. Do I need to bring anything with me aside from the Interment Request/Authorization and Payment form?**

If you are interment rights for future use, you are required to provide two (2) pieces of identification, and payment in full.

If you are purchasing interment rights for a loved one who has already died, you are required to provide two (2) pieces of identification, the completed Interment Request/Authorization and Payment form, death certificate, and payment in full. No interment will be authorized until all required documentation is received.

### **4. Can I specify who can be buried in my lot(s) now?**

Yes you can by simply completing the Allocation Document form at the time of purchase or anytime after by contact the Town at 519.776.7336 or [clerks@essex.ca](mailto:clerks@essex.ca)
