




COLCHESTER SOUTH SEWAGE WORKS EXPANSION MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

The Town of Essex undertook a Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) for the upgrade of the existing Colchester South sewage works and expansion of the existing service area to accommodate ongoing and future development within the community. This study satisfied Phases 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Class EA process which involved public and review agency consultation, an evaluation of alternative solutions/design concepts, an assessment of the potential environmental effects of the proposed works, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts that may result.



The Environmental Study Report documents the planning and decision-making process of this Class EA. The Environmental Study Report has been completed and is being placed on the public record for a 30-day review period starting October 27th, 2023, and ending on November 27th, 2023. A request may be made to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for an Order requiring a higher level of study, or that conditions be imposed, only on the grounds that the requested order may prevent, mitigate or remedy adverse impacts on constitutionally protected Aboriginal and treaty rights. Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include your contact information and be received by November 27th, 2023.

Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for additional conditions or a request for an individual/comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate or remedy those potential adverse impacts on Aboriginal and treaty rights, and any information in support of the statements in the request. This will ensure that the ministry is able to efficiently begin reviewing the request.
